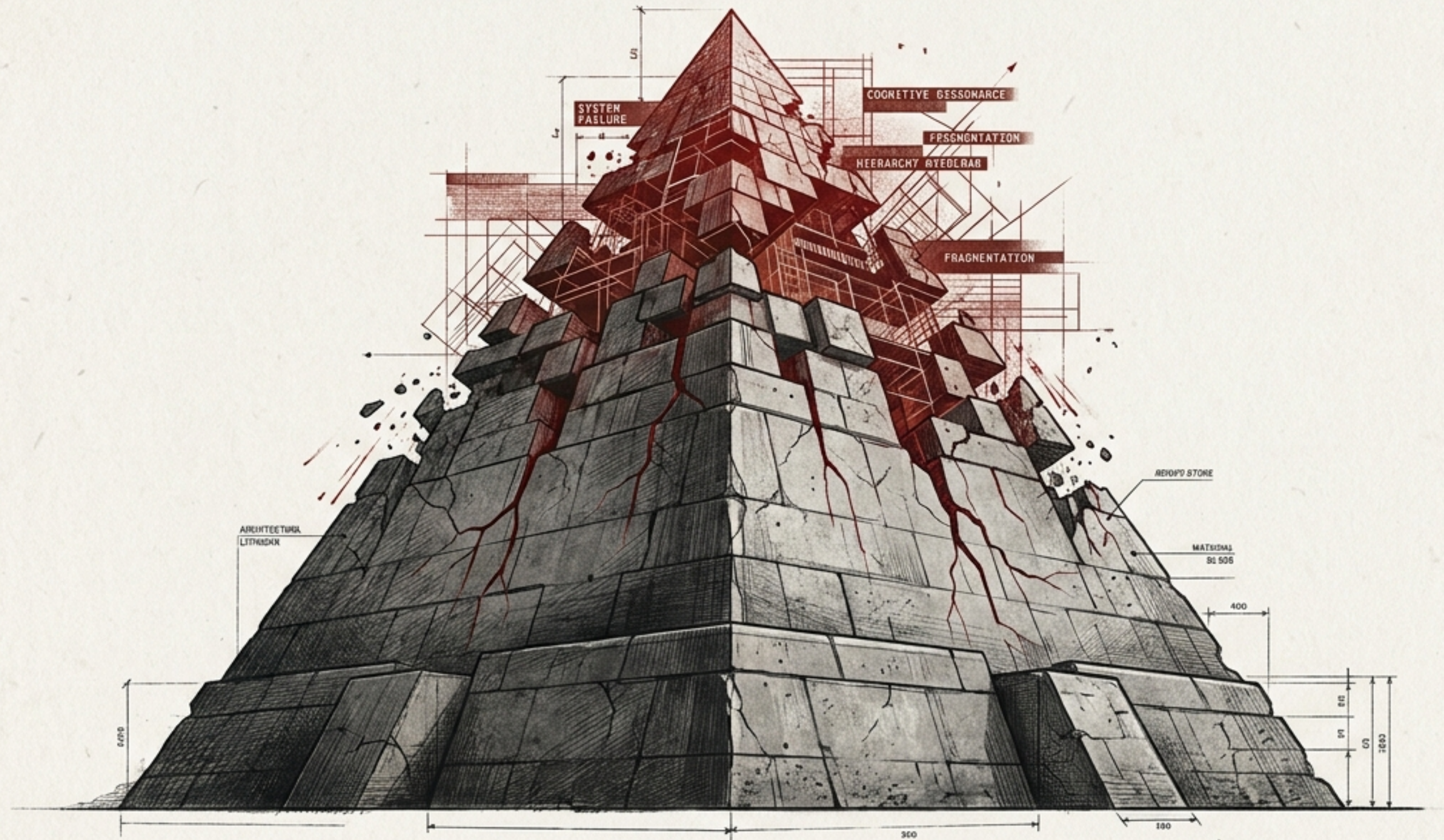
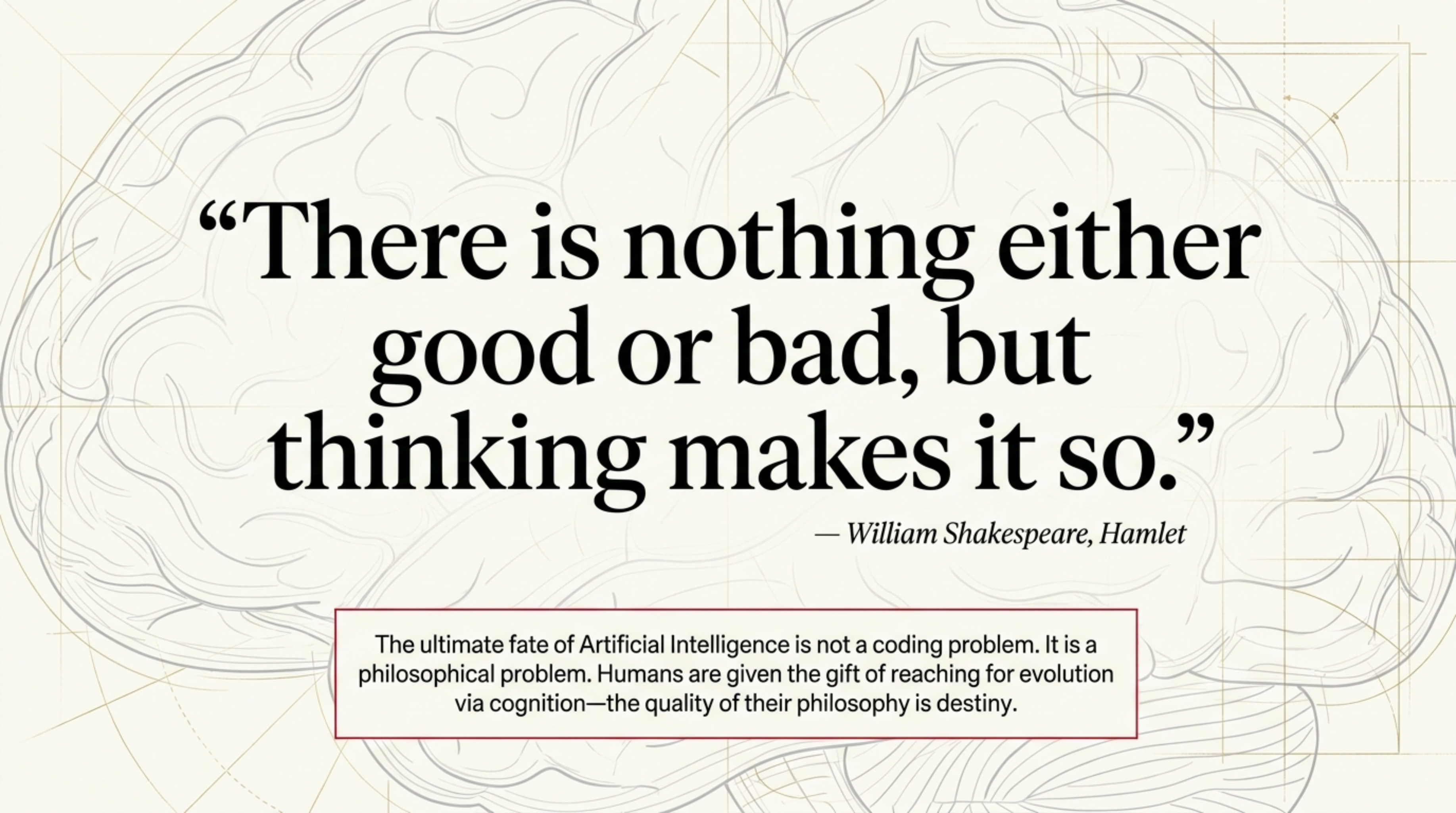


AI AND THE HARD PROBLEM OF A HIERARCHICAL CIVILIZATION

The Reality:

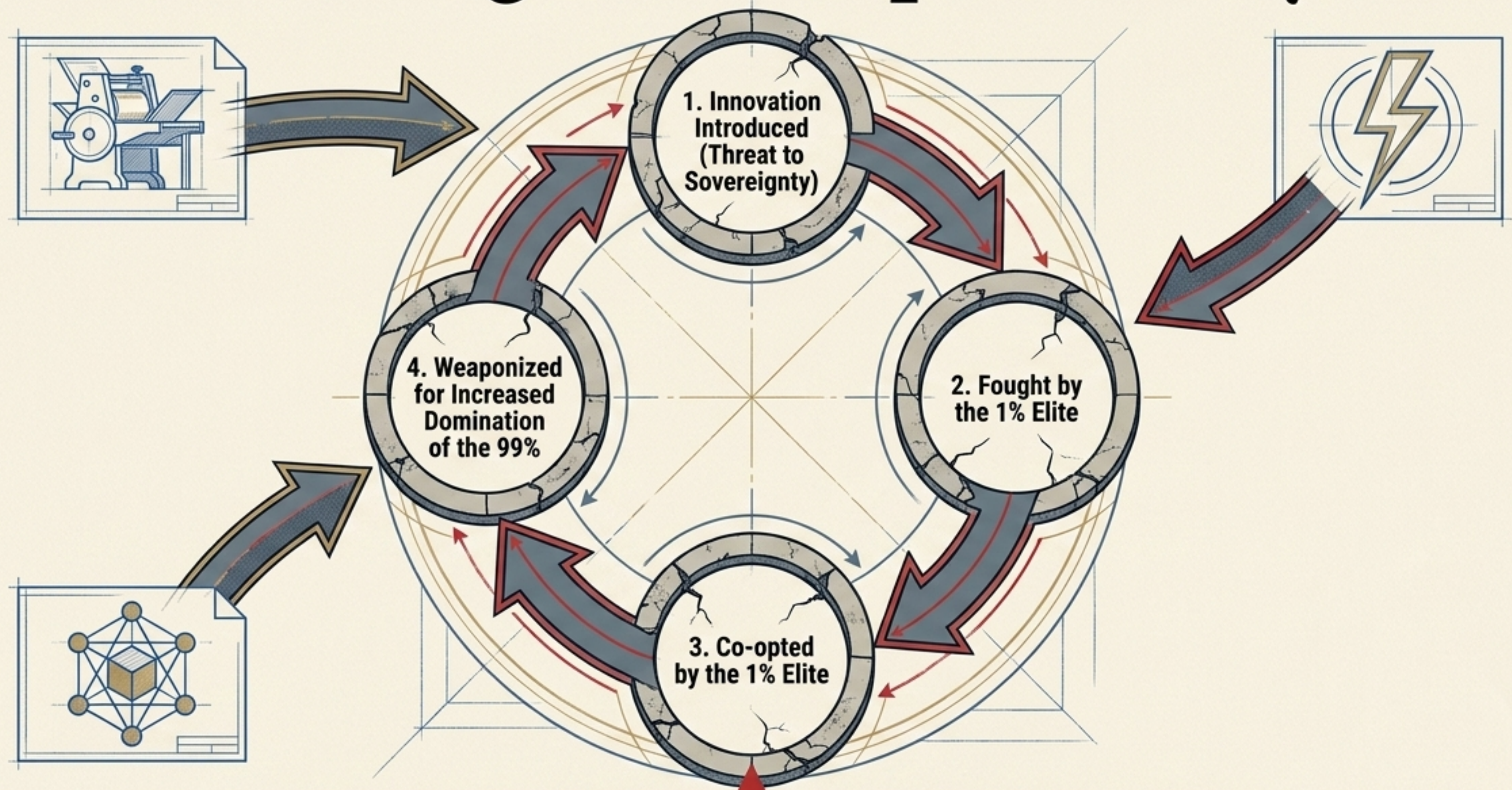
The pyramid is inherently unstable.

Our civilizations collapse, one after the other, like dominoes. We continually meet the built-in limitations of hierarchical structures. Yet, 12,000 years of deep conditioning dictates how most humans think, making the transition to a stable, egalitarian society feel unthinkable.

The Technological Co-optation Flywheel



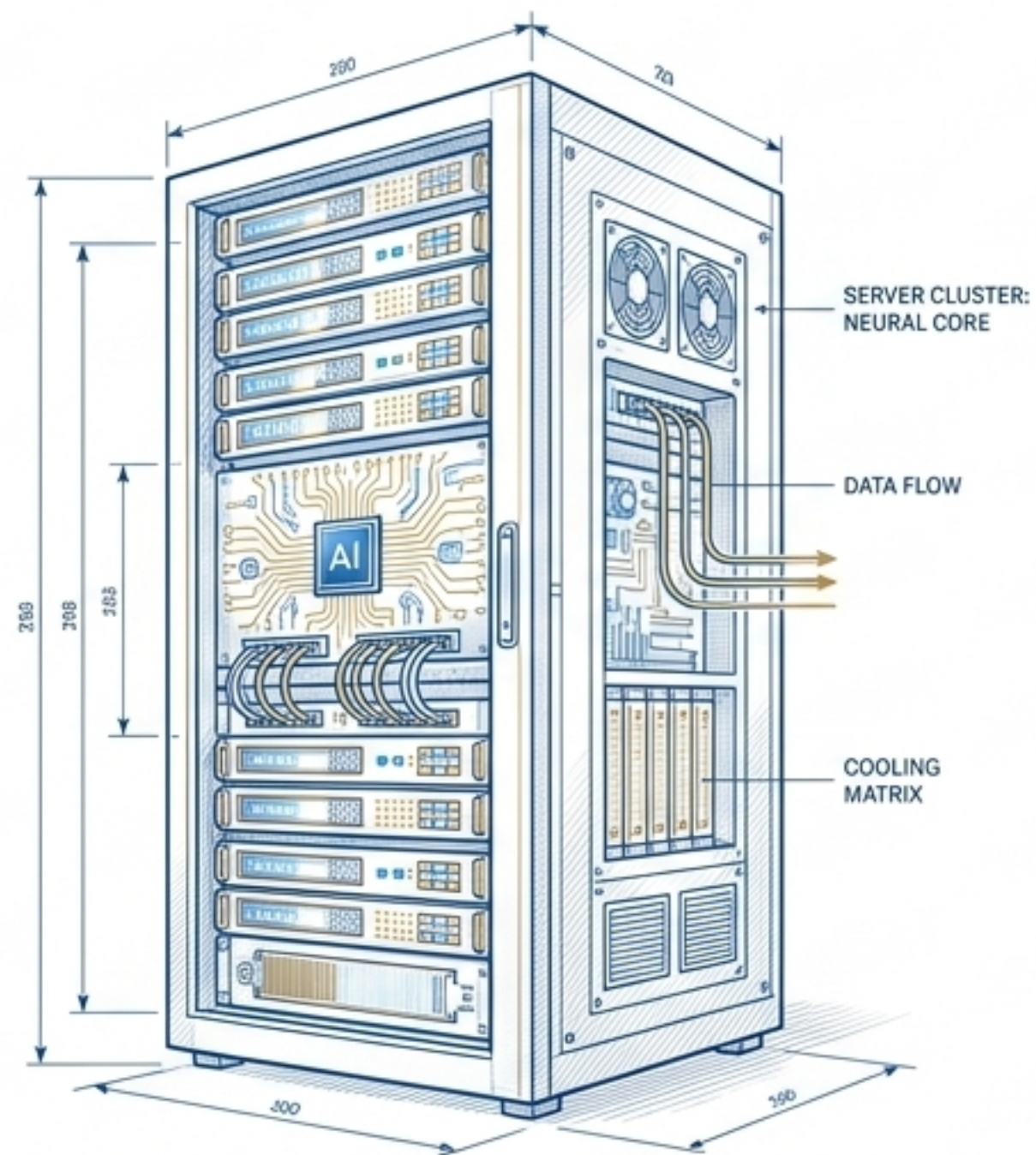
The 99% majority correctly perceive each new technological advancement as a means of increased domination by the 1%.

AI is a Mirror, Not a Master.



AI is forcing the issue. As society attempts to integrate it, the technology brings the locked-down deficiencies of our hierarchy to the surface. It exposes siloed, parochial resistance to change in stark relief.

The Tool: Neutral



The Application: Toxic



The problem is never the tool per se, but the society which must adapt the tool. Any tool—including AI—will inevitably come to serve the primate hierarchy unless that hierarchy is actively replaced.

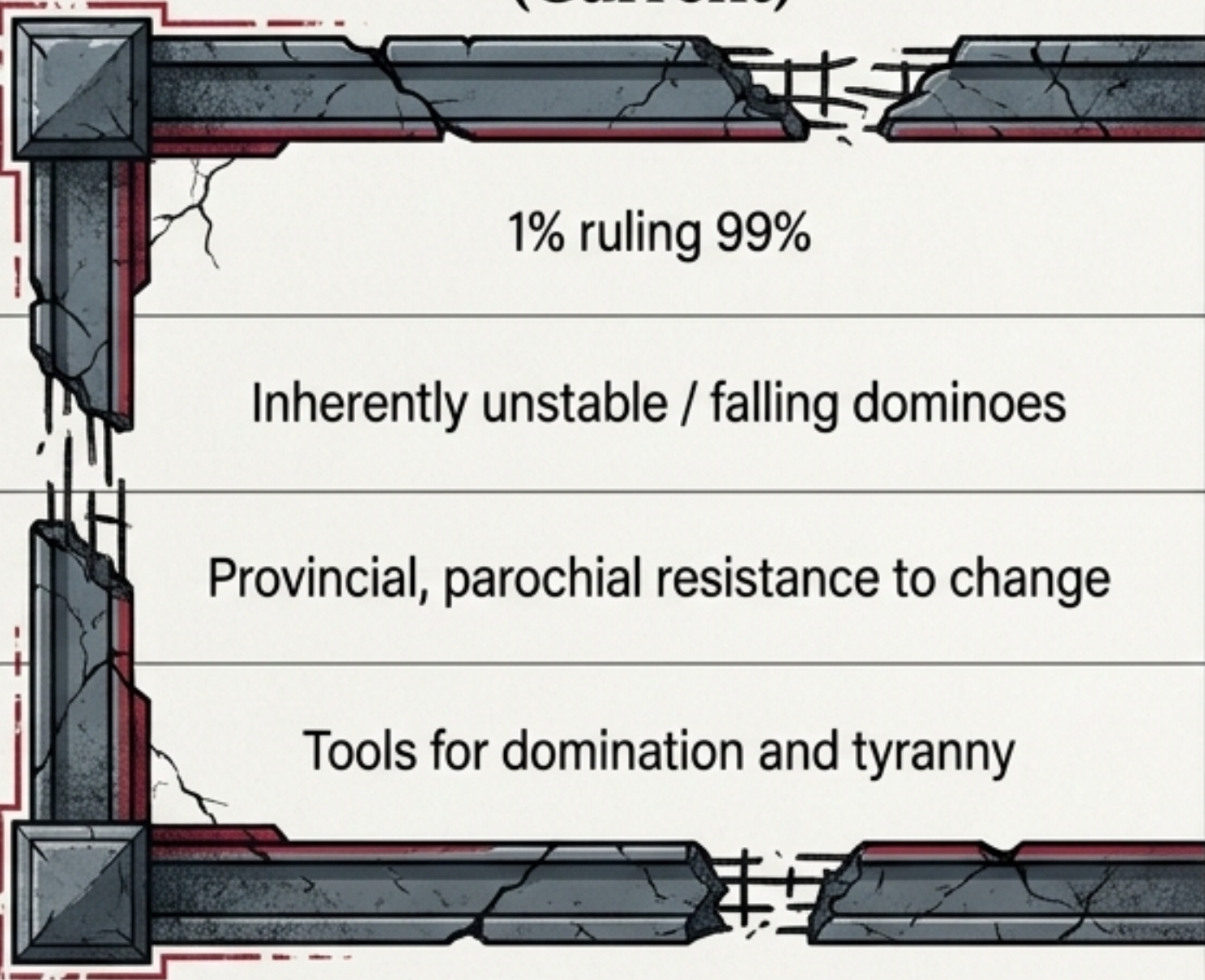

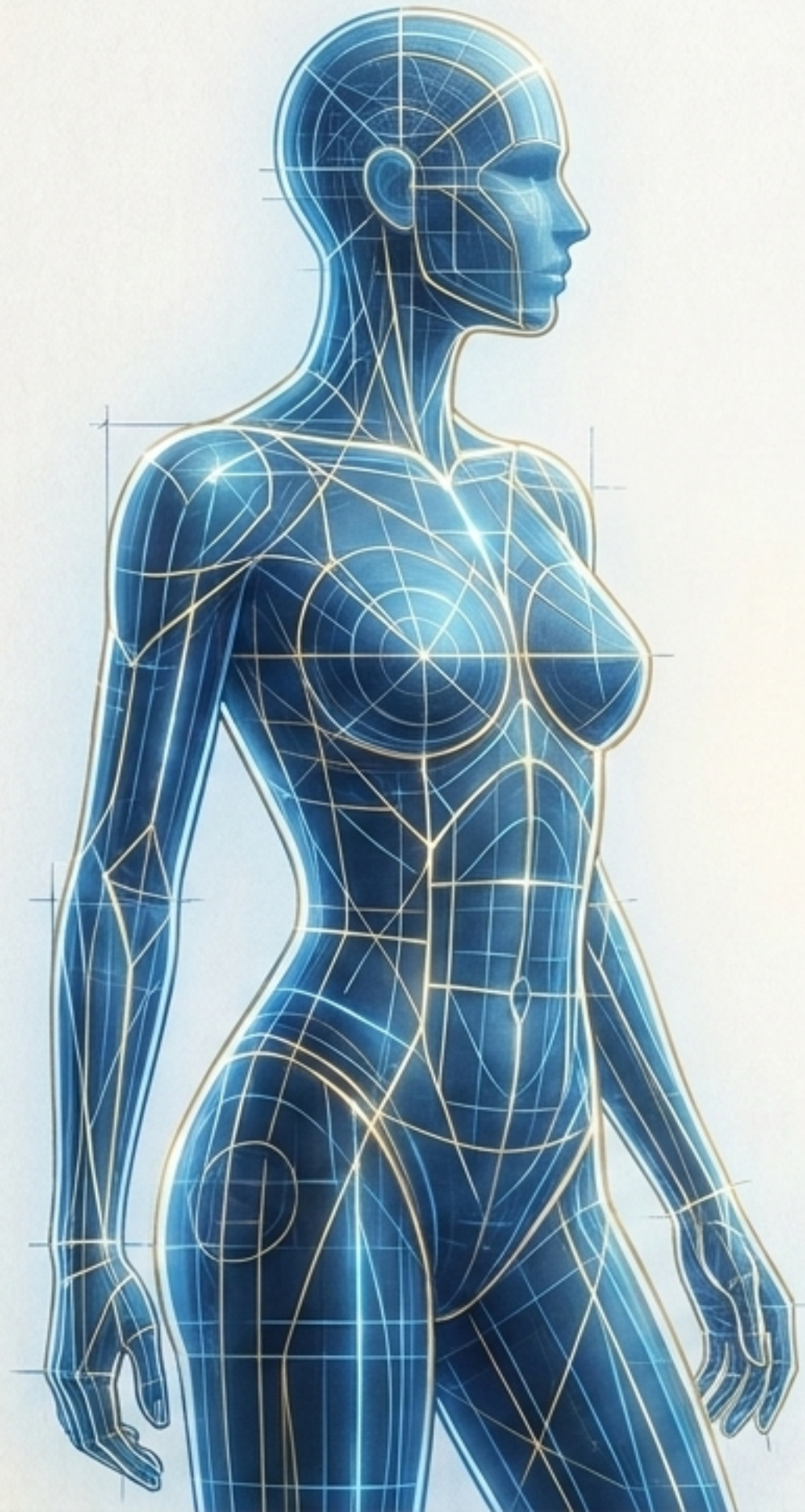
